Description

The purpose of this Toolbox is to provide authentic training for students interested in the Electrotechnology Servicing Industry. This toolbox covers eight units of competency in the Certificate II of Electrotechnology Servicing - Security (UTE29597): three core units, three elective units and two specialisation units.

These units reflect the core activities that the majority of employees in the security industry will be required to carry out. The tasks are easily customised to cater for specific domestic and commercial security systems and their associated components.
